LITIGATION SUPPORT AND EXPERT WITNESS SERVICES Roles, Expectations, and Limitations

This session will introduce participants to all of the key issues for experts to consider when performing expert witness services for ADA and other accessibility cases

Objectives:

- Using a scope of services checklist participants will differentiate the various common roles and scopes of services typically provided for plaintiff and defense attorneys on ADA and other accessibility cases.

- 4. Participants will enumerate all of the parts of an expert report for an ADA lawsuit and be able to structure a well-researched and substantiated expert opinion.
- 5. Participants will analyze different approaches attorneys use in questioning opposing experts, what types of traps they will often set, and how to avoid them.
- 6. Reviewing real-life examples, participants will develop an appreciation for the role of careful analysis and consistent integrity to protect their clients' interests, and their own futures as experts.
